Dogs in Pryor Meadows

The board has had several reports of aggressive dogs in Pryor Meadows. If you own a dog you need to be familiar with the Lee's Summit Animal Control ordinances.

If you encounter an aggressive dog, if you or a member of your family are bitten by a dog or your dog is attacked by an unrestrained dog, please contact Animal Control immediately to report the incident. (816-969-1640)

We have highlighted a few polices related to dog ownership.

1. Lee's Summit has a "leash law" meaning all dogs must be restrained at all times. (See ordinance for a detailed description)
2. Dogs cannot be tethered more than 30 minutes at a time with a total of no more than 3 hours in a 24 hour period
3. Dogs must have a current vaccination for rabies and licensed with the city.
4. City ordinance states that no more than 3 pets are allowed per residence. PM restrictions say no more than 2 pets allowed per residence.
5. Lee's Summit has a mandatory Spay/Neuter program. See ordinance 5.141
